CORQ

- CORQ is the mobile version of Engage, its primary use is to search and register for events on campus!
- Once you sign into CORQ with your SHU credentials an Event pass is created that you can present as attendance at events.
- You can also contact organizations through CORQ!

CHECK-IN

- Check-in is used to track attendance at events!
- Once you download the app you can input the code generated by Engage (which you can find on the Event page) and scan Event Passes, attendance is automatically uploaded, and a running count of attendees can be seen as well.

- Engage is the mother platform for all of Student Engagement. It's where you request to join clubs, submit all organization related requests, search for events, and even track attendance.
- Engage allows you to access more information than CORQ because if you are an e-board member you have access to your organization as well as your personal account.
